Satkosia, located at the confluence of both the Deccan Peninsula as well as the Eastern Ghats, is rich in vegetation and fauna. It is a great place for environment enthusiasts and bird watchers to explore the nearby Satkosia Gorge Sanctuary.

On a river safari, you can see wildlife such as howling deer, hedgehogs, antelope, tiger, Malabar giant squirrels, and others. In the evenings, you can play volleyball, rifle shooting, or archery with your pals.
